
Subject:- Calculation of monthly contribution towards cost of Pension payable during foreign service.

The undersigned is directed to invite reference to this Ministry's Office Memorandum No. F.19(24)-E.V.(A)/73 dated 9.8.1974. Apropos the orders contained therein, Dearness Allowance and Interim Relief as admissible under the orders in force on 31.12.1972 is treated as emolument for the purpose of determining pension and D.C.R. Gratuity, besides Pay and dearness pay (as admissible) in respect of Govt. servants who opt for revised scale subsequent to the date of 1.1.1973 or retain their existing scales.

A question has arisen as to what should be basis for recovery of Pension contribution in respect of such Govt. servant on foreign service. The case has been examined and the President is pleased to decide that for the purpose of recovery of contribution corresponding revised scales published in C.C.S. (R.P.) Rules, 1973 should be taken as the basis for calculation.

2. These orders take effect from 1.1.1973.
3. In so far as the employees of the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders have been issued in consultation with Comptroller and Auditor General of India.
