NOTIFICATION

S.O. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Fundamental Rules, namely:-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Fundamental (First Amendment) Rules, 1976.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January, 1973.

2. In the Fundamental Rules, in the Schedule to Rule 30, for entry (13), the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

"(13) Posts of Higher Selection Grade-I Postmasters in the Post and Telegraphs Department when held by Assistant Superintendent of Post Offices."

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The amendment sought to be made by this notification was already made by the Fundamental (Third Amendment) Rules, 1975 issued on 26.4.75. This took effect from the date of its publication in the Gazette of India. The amendment was necessitated because of the revision of the pay scales of Assistant Superintendent of Post Offices and HSG-I Post Masters on the recommendations of the Third Pay Commission which took effect from 1.1.73. Accordingly it was necessary that the aforesaid amendment should have effect from 1.1.73, the date of revision of the pay scales. The present amendment seeks to achieve this object. By giving retrospective effect to this amendment w.e.f. 1.1.73, no Government servant is likely to be adversely affected.
