Subject:- Pay and allowances of contingent paid staff not brought on to regular establishment.



In supersession of the orders contained in para (2)(c) of this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.F.1(10)-Est. (Spl)/49 dated 16th June, 1949, the undersigned is directed to say that the Government of India have decided that employees paid from contingencies who are not brought on to regular establishment (i.e. who are classed as 'casual' employees) shall, with effect from the 1st July, 1959, be entitled to a fixed pay of Rs.70/-p.m. or such other pay as may be fixed in individual cases by special orders. In addition to this, they will be entitled to dearness, compensatory and other allowances at the same rates and in the same manner as are

prescribed for Class-IV staff belonging to regular establishments with effect from the same date. They shall not be eligible to leave, pension, medical attendance or travelling allowance benefits.


