OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Counting of Maternity leave for increments in the case of temporary and officiating Government servants.

.....

/second The undersigned is directed to invite attention to the recommendation contained in paragraph 21, Chapter XXXVI of the Report, of the Pay Commission that the period of maternity leave should be allowed to count for increments in the case of temporary and officiating service also. This has been carefully considered by the Government of India and it has been decided that the recommendation of the Pay Commission should be accepted. Accordingly, maternity leave granted to female Government servants under the provisions of S.R. 267 may be allowed to count for increments in the post in which the Government servant was officiating at the time of proceeding on such leave provided it is certified by the appointing authority that the Government servant concerned would have continued to officiate in that post or a post on the same time-scale but for proceeding on such leave.

2. These orders will take effect from the date of issue.

3. Necessary amendments to the Fundamental Rules will be issued in due course.

4. In so far as persons serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders have been issued after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.


