OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Central Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1960 -  
Revised scales for common categories of posts.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry's Notification No. F.12(1)-Est(Spl)/60 dated the 2nd August, 1960, promulgating the Central Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1960. The Schedule to these rules is divided into two parts, Part 'A' and part 'B'. Part 'A' refers to the categories of posts common to all or many Departments of the Government of India which carried identical prescribed scales and for which identical revised scales have been prescribed. Part 'B' contains revised scales for posts under various Ministries/Departments which have not been included in Part 'A'. As some of the posts covered by entries in Part 'A' of the Schedule have also been included in Part 'B', doubts have been expressed whether Part 'A' of the Schedule is only a summary of the various scales common to all or many Departments of the Government of India, and whether holders of the posts covered by the Part 'A', may be allowed the revised scales in the absence of a specific entry in respect of those posts again in Part 'B' of the Schedule. The undersigned is accordingly directed to clarify that it is not the intention to show the posts covered by Part 'A' of the Schedule separately in the Sections relating to various Ministries/Departments in Part 'B' unless they carry a pre-1931 scale. For example any Class II post, whatever its designation, on the prescribed scale of Rs.275-25-500-EB-30-650-EB-30-800 will carry the revised scale of Rs.350-900, and it will not appear in Part 'B' unless it carried a pre-1931 scale of pay. Similarly any Class IV post, including a workshop post, on the prescribed scale of Rs.35-1-50 will carry the revised scale of Rs.75-95.

In a few cases, however, posts covered by Part 'A' of the Schedule have been shown also in Part 'B' of the Schedule through an oversight even though they do not carry any pre-1931 scales. Necessary action to delete the superfluous entries will be taken in due course.

2. In view of the position stated above, persons holding posts covered by the general entries in Part 'A' of the Schedule were required to exercise their option by 1st December, 1960, without awaiting a separate notification in respect of such posts in the Sections relating to the Department or offices in which they were working. They should, therefore, be permitted to draw pay in the revised scales, unless they have exercised option to retain the existing scales.
