Subject:- Fixation of pay under the C.C.S.(R.P)  
Rules, 1960 of persons who were on deputation,  
foreign service, joining time, leave or under  
suspension on the date of coming over to the  
revised scales.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No.GA.III/12330 dated the 1st March, 1961, on the subject mentioned above, and to say that the pay on the revised scale is to be fixed with reference to the stage on which pay is drawn in the existing scale. In this connection your attention is invited to the explanation under Rule 5(3) which provides that in the case of Govt.servants on deputation out of India or on leave or on foreign service, the existing scale includes the scale applicable to the post which he would have held but for his being on deputation out of India, or on leave/or on foreign service. Thus in such cases the pay will be fixed with reference to the scale and the pay will ~~be fixed with reference to the scale and the pay that would have been drawn but for such deputation, leave or foreign service.~~

2. In the case of persons on joining time on the crucial date the basic pay will be the pay that would be admissible on that date under F.R.107.

3. Under rule 9(1)(ii) of the Central Civil Services(Revised Pay) Rules, 1960, persons, who were under suspension on 1-7-59, x can opt for the revised scales within 4 months of the date of return to duty. Their existing scale and basic pay will be determined on the basis of the rates sanctioned to them under F.R.54 on their return to duty.

Subject: - Revision of pay under the D.C.B. (I) Rules, 1956 of persons who were on deputation to foreign services, including those who were on deputation on the date of coming over to the revised scales.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. D.111/12120 dated the 1st March, 1961, on the subject mentioned above, and to say that the pay on the revised scale is to be fixed with reference to the date on which pay is drawn in the existing scale. In this connection your attention is invited to the explanation under Rule 2(2) which provides that in the case of persons on deputation out of India or on leave or on extension of service, the existing scale is to be applied to the post which he would have held but for his being on deputation out of India, or on leave or on extension of service. Thus in such cases the pay will be fixed with reference to the scale and the pay will be fixed with reference to the scale and the pay will have been drawn but for such deputation, leave or extension of service.

2. In the case of persons on deputation from the regular service the basic pay will be the pay that would be paid to him on that date under the D.C.B. (I) Rules, 1956.

3. That the D.C.B. (I) of the Central Civil Services (Pay) Rules, 1956, persons who were under suspension on 1-7-56, can opt for the revised scales with effect from the date of return to duty. Their existing scale and basic pay will be determined on the basis of the rates applicable to them under the D.C.B. (I) Rules, 1956.
