
OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Central Civil Services (R.P) Rules, 1973-
Revised scale of pay for Pharmacists.

The undersigned is directed to invite a reference to this Ministry's O.M.No.5(4)-E.III(A)/68 dated the 1st March, 1968 (copy enclosed) in which it was laid down that unqualified Compounders/Pharmacists/Dispensers who have completed 10 years of Service may be allowed the scale of Rs.130-240 (sanctioned for fully qualified Pharmacists in accordance with the recommendation of the Second Pay Commission). The recommendation of the Third Pay Commission with regard to revised scales of Pharmacists are contained in para 125 of chapter 16 of Vol. I of their Report. According to these, the unqualified Pharmacists have been allowed two scales, namely, the lower scale of Rs.260-350 and the higher scale of Rs.330-480 (corresponding to the pre-revised scales of fully qualified Pharmacists). The revised scale recommended for fully qualified Pharmacists is Rs.330-560 to which unqualified Pharmacists drawing pay in the revised scale of Rs.330-480 have been recommended to be eligible after 10 years of service.

2. The above recommendations of the Third Pay Commission having been considered by the Government, the President is now pleased to decide that unqualified Pharmacists may be allowed (i) the revised scale of Rs.330-480 after ten years of service in the revised scale of Rs.260-350 (including service in the corresponding pre-revised scales of Rs.110-155, Rs.95-155 and Rs.80-110), (ii) the revised scale of Rs.330-560 (sanctioned for fully qualified Pharmacists) after rendering 10 years service in the revised scale of Rs.330-480 including service in the corresponding pre-revised scales of Rs.130-300; Rs.130-240; Rs.131-180 and Rs.110-180.

3. These orders will take effect from 1.1.1973.
