
OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Deputation of Central Government servants on foreign service with Asian Development Bank - Participation in the Staff Retirement Plan of the Bank.

The undersigned is directed to invite a reference to this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.F.1(18)-E.III(B)/69 dated the 28th May, 1970 in accordance with which officers of the All India Services and Central Services on foreign service with IMF/IBRD are allowed an option to join the Staff Retirement Plan of those organisations as full members subject to the same conditions as laid down in this Ministry's Office Memorandum No. F.1(16)-E.III(B)/66 dated the 5th November, 1966. The President is now pleased to decide that Officers of All India Services and Central Services on deputation to foreign service with the Asian Development Bank will also have the option to join the Staff Retirement Plan of the Bank as full members subject to the same conditions as laid down in this Ministry's Office Memorandum No. F.1(16)-E.III(B)/66 dated the 5th November, 1966.

2. In so far as the persons serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders are issued after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.
