employees - Pay Commission's recommendations

The undersigned is directed to refer to the sub para (c) of para 1 of this Ministry's Office Memorandum No. F.8(7)-Est(Spl)/60, dated the 7th January 1961 on the subject mentioned above according to which the three National Holidays will be compulsory for all categories of staff and will be treated as paid holidays in respect of daily rated staff. A point has been raised whether these three National Holidays will be treated as paid Holidays in respect of daily rated casual labour irrespective of any condition. After careful examination it has been decided that the casual employees including daily rated staff will be entitled to

paid holidays on these three National Holidays only if they are in service on the preceding and succeeding working days.
