
OFFICE MEMORANDUM.

Subject:- Applicability of the Central Civil Service (Revised Pay) Rules, 1960, to persons who ceased to be in Government service between the 1st July, 1959 and 2nd August, 1960.

The undersigned is directed to refer to paragraph 3 of this Ministry's Office Memorandum No. F. 12(4)-Est. (Spl.)/60, dated the 2nd March, 1961, laying down the procedure regarding options on behalf of Government servants who died between the 1st July, 1959 and the 2nd August, 1960, or those who die or died after the 2nd August, 1960, without exercising an option within the prescribed time limit. A question has been raised as to the authority who should initiate action in accordance with these orders for payment of arrears etc. in respect of deceased Government servants.

2. It has been decided that in respect of the non-gazetted Government servants, it will be the 'Head of the Office' who will take action not only to have the payment of arrears made under the above orders but also to sanction the death-cum-retirement gratuity and/or family pension on the basis of the pay as refixed on the revised scale. In respect of Gazetted

Government servants, the administrative authority will move the Audit Officer to issue the salary slip in the revised scales and thereafter take action to pay the arrears and also to have the death-cum-retirement gratuity and/or family pension, revised.


