OFFICER MEMORANDUM

Subject: Fixation of pay of re-employed pensioners-General policy thereof.

.....

The grant of provisional pay to re-employed pensioners pending fixation of their final pay is governed by the orders contained in the Ministry of Finance Office Memorandum 8(63)-Est.III/60 dated 12.1.1961 and 16.11.1961.

2. The Administrative Ministries while issuing sanction for provisional payments of pay etc. to re-employed personnel have to furnish the particulars required in paragraph 3 of the O.M. 8(63)-Est.III/60 dated 12.1.61 to the Audit/Pay and Accounts Officer to enable him to check that prima facie the rate of provisional pay has been correctly fixed. It has been represented that delay in furnishing the relevant particulars by the Administrative Ministries to the Audit/Pay and Accounts Officer results in delay in the issue of provisional pay slip. In order to avoid delay in the issue of provisional pay slip, it has been decided that whenever the Administrative Ministries are not able to give the details which would enable the Audit/Pay and Accounts Officer to fix the pay of re-employed persons, they should in the copy of orders of re-employment which they endorse to the re-employed person, indicate to him that he should supply to the Audit/Pay and Accounts Officer concerned the particulars required in paragraph 3 of the O.M. dated 12.1.61. on the strength of which the Audit/Pay and Accounts Officer could issue a provisional pay slip pending formal verification of the particulars from his own officer or from the Audit/Pay and Accounts Officer concerned.

3. In so far as the persons serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, the orders are issued in consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India who will exercise the powers of an Administrative Ministry for the purpose of these orders in respect of persons re-employed in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department.
