OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Fixation of pay of ex-combatant clerks retired/
released from service in the Armed Forces on re-
employment as LDCs/Junior Clerks in Civil Deptts.

.....

The undersigned is directed to say that the President has been pleased to decide that the provisions contained in this Ministry's O.M.No.F.6(8)-E.III/63 dated the 11th April 1963, will have effect from the 30th May, 1960.

2. Ex-combatant clerks re-employed as LDCs/Junior Clerks in Civil Deptts. before the 30th May, 1960, may be given an option to get their pay refixed with effect from the 30th May, 1960 under these orders as if they were re-employed from that date. Those who so opt will not be eligible for the benefit of the civil service rendered prior to that date but they may be allowed to retain the benefit of the ad hoc increments, if any, already earned by them under the Ministry of Home Affairs Office Memorandum No.30/53-CS(D) dated the 9th October, 1954. The option should be exercised within six months from the date of issue of this Office Memorandum. The option once exercised shall be final.

3. No arrears as a result of the application of these orders will be admissible for the period prior to the date of their issue.

4. In so far the persons serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders are issued in consultation with the Comptroller & Auditor General.
